

Air force base receives new floor treatment

The refurbished Makhado Air Force base in Louis Trichardt, Limpopo, has seen its hangars decked out with a.b.e. Construction Chemicals' abeflo epoxy flooring system.

Eric Gouws, a.b.e. flooring sales consultant based in Boksburg, says, "abeflo is a four-component, solvent-free, self-levelling system for flooring which caters for high hygiene standards. It offers good colour retention and a medium gloss finish. The system has been used successfully for flooring of hospitals, schools, showrooms, supermarkets, canteens, restaurants, laboratories and a range of applications where hygiene is a priority."

At the Air Force base, a 2 mm application of abeflo was used over the total floor area of 4 500 m². The application was done by Madithapa Sandblasting and Flooring. a.b.e.'s abecote 440 and 441 acrylic enamel coatings were used subsequently to demarcate the floors.

The abeflo system has also been selected recently for the refurbishment of flooring in the Aspen Pharmacare warehouses in East London.
