Makhado Air Force base in Louis Trichardt; at Aspen Pharmacare in East London; and the Viegsville Supermarket, near Mthatha in the Eastern Cape.

Eric Gouws, abe flooring sales consultant, says a 2mm version of abeflo was applied to the airbase floors by applicators, Madithapa Sandblasting and Flooring. "abeflo is a four-component, solvent-free, self-levelling system for flooring which caters for high hygiene standards, and offers good colour retention and a medium gloss finish.

The system has been successfully applied for flooring of hospitals, schools, showrooms, supermarkets, canteens, restaurants, laboratories and a wide variety of situations where hygiene was a major priority."

Peter Jones, abe's regional manager in the Eastern Cape, says the abeflo system was applied by Proseal for 500m² of refurbished flooring at the Aspen Pharmacare warehouses in East London. "Aspen's old floor was first grinded with a vacuum extractor orbital grinder, before abecote wd 337 primer was applied prior to the laying of 2mm abeflo 'medium sea grey' flooring," Peter notes.

For the Viegsville Supermarket in the old Transkei, the existing screed also had to be grinded initially. "abe's ap-

proved applicator, Cote Rite, then had to cut out 50mm by 10mm on either side of the expansion joints and fill the cavities with epoxy prior to the application of abecote primer and a 3mm layer of abeflo," he adds.

Flooring Limpopo **airbase**

An epoxy self-levelling flooring system from abe Construction Chemicals has been applied in three major new projects. The abeflo system was specified for the renovation of 4 500m² of aircraft and battery bay hangars at the
